## Speakers Biographies



### Alistair Sutherland QPM

#### Assistant Commissioner City of London Police

Alistair joined the Metropolitan Police Service in 1986. In 2003 he was appointed to the Met's senior officer cadre in charge of policing major events across London. In 2009 he set up a new unit taking responsibility for the command and control of police firearms operations following the Stockwell Inquiry into the shooting of Jean Charles de Menezes and subsequently he took charge of SCO19, the Met's Specialist Firearms Unit. Alistair was promoted to Commander in July 2014 and took up the role of Commander for Royalty, Diplomatic and Specialist Protection. He is a Director of the National Counter Terrorism Commanders Course as well as being a member of the Counter Terrorism Commander cadre. In April 2016 he joined the City of London Police as Assistant Commissioner and in June 2018 he was awarded the Queen's Police Medal (QPM) for distinguished service.



### Dean Haydon QPM

#### Senior National Coordinator - Counter Terrorism Policing- Metropolitan Police

In May 2018, Deputy Assistant Commissioner Dean Haydon was appointed as the Senior National Coordinator for UK Counter Terrorism Policing, responsible for delivering the police response to the Pursue and Prevent elements of the Government's CONTEST strategy. In this role he co-ordinates the policing response to threats arising from terrorism and domestic extremism nationally. The CT policing network has built a worldwide reputation for excellence and is regularly deployed nationally and internationally in the global fight against terrorism. Prior to this appointment, he was Commander of New Scotland Yard's Counter Terrorism Command (SO15), managing both London and International Operations. In 2017, the UK experienced an unprecedented level of terrorist attacks and associated disrupted activity. DAC Haydon was at the forefront of managing and leading the UK response in addition to managing the press and media as the national spokesperson.



### Dr. Nicole Lipkin Psy.D., M.B.A.

#### CEO, Equilibria Leadership Consulting & Equilibria PCS

Dr. Nicole Lipkin is an internationally recognized organizational psychologist specializing in leadership and organizational development, executive coaching and consulting. She is a keynote speaker and has spoken to audiences large and small across the world on topics related to leadership. Nicole is the CEO of Equilibria Leadership Consulting, a leadership development and executive coaching firm. Nicole is the author of the best-selling leadership book What Keeps Leaders Up At Night. She has shared her expertise on NPR, NBC, Forbes, Entrepreneur, CBS, and other national and international media outlets. Nicole has a doctoral in clinical psychology, Master of Business Administration, and Master of Criminal Justice. She is an adjunct faculty member at the industry-leading Center for Creative Leadership and is also a board certified and ICF certified executive coach and licensed psychologist.



### Peter Neumann

#### International Centre for the Study of Radicalisation & Political Violence, Kings College, London

Peter Neumann is Professor of Security Studies at the Department of War Studies, Kings College London and in early 2008 founded the International Centre for the Study of Radicalisation. In 2017 he also served as the OSCE Chairmans Special Representative on Countering Violent radicalization. He is the author of numerous peer-reviewed articles, dealing with different aspects of terrorism and radicalization, especially "homegrown" radicalization in Western countries. He has led research projects and written influential policy reports about the crime-terror nexus, on line radicalization, foreign fighter networks, terrorist defectors, prison-based de radicalization programs and terrorist recruitment in Europe. ICSR's ground breaking research on foreign fighters – for which he serves as principal investigator, has informed policy makers and public opinion in Europe and North America. He has taught courses on terrorism, counter terrorism, intelligence, radicalization and counter radicalization at Kings College London. Peter serves as an investigator for the National Consortium for the Study of Terrorism and Responses to Terrorism at the University of Maryland.



### David Sumner CISM

#### Director - Bishopsgate Kinsman Ltd

#### (Former Police Superintendent & Head of Police Intelligence - NATO Mission in Afghanistan)

David is a former Police Director of Intelligence and Head of Criminal Justice. He served on the NATO Mission Resolute Support in Afghanistan as the Senior Police Intelligence Advisor to the Mission Commander and was the appointed Mentor to the Director General of the Afghan Police Intelligence Service. Whilst deployed on the mission he gave expert advice to the Afghan Home Secretary on intelligence management and data security. David is a qualified Data Protection Officer and is actively involved leading Privacy, Compliance and Security Management implementation in organisations as an independent consultant. He has successfully influenced government for amendments to post Brexit UK Data Protection Draft Legislation.

In the wake of 2017's numerous terrorist attacks across the UK, National Counter Terrorism Policing Headquarters declared a 'step change' in the national threat level and called for greater partnerships between the public (policing) and private (business) sectors. As the two Business Improvement Districts deeply affected by the attack on Borough Market on 3rd June 2017, we couldn't agree more with this approach and indeed have been working to establish such partnerships since our inception more than 12 years ago.

Team London Bridge and Better Bankside are two separately run Business Improvement Districts (BIDs) – private organisations funded by local businesses to deliver a range of projects and services to improve the

trading environment, with a combined footprint stretching south of the Thames approximately from Blackfriars Bridge to Tower Bridge and as far south as Union Street/Newcomen Street. Considering the high-profile nature of the area, building a safer and more resilient community has always been a priority for both BIDs and to achieve it requires working in partnership with one another, the emergency services, local authority and of course our business members.

At a strategic level we co-ordinate the Southwark Security & Resilience Forum – a group of the fifty or so largest, and from a security perspective most significant, businesses across our Community Security Zone. The quarterly meetings allow security managers from the various organisations to meet one another, share best practice, learn from guest speakers and run table-top exercises. Undoubtedly key to this is the strong attendance and input from local police teams (both Met and BTP) who have always shown a willingness to work alongside and assist the business community.

Both Team London Bridge and Better Bankside fund additional Met police officers for our respective areas through MOPAC's 'Met Patrol Plus' initiative. The officers are an invaluable resource at a time when neighbourhood policing is stretched and can dedicate the time and personal engagement that's needed for intelligence gathering and implementing effective local crime reduction solutions. High visibility patrols and regular interaction with security teams at some of London's most high-risk sites dissuades hostile reconnaissance and has led to actionable intelligence being passed to counter terrorism colleagues. In the hours following the Borough Market attack our officers were tasked with making reassurance visits to businesses (bars, restaurants and pubs in particular) which freed other officers to staff cordons and patrol elsewhere, notwithstanding the great deal of confidence it inspired in the police response.

We also arrange a number of Project Argus and ACT Awareness sessions throughout the year, as well as running general business continuity workshops – the latter being particularly useful for smaller businesses who lack the in-house capability or skills to undertake this themselves. Following the events of the 3rd June 2017, we reflected on the fact that many of the affected premises had successfully implemented the advice given during counter terrorism briefings (likely saving lives) and by sheer co-incidence Borough Market's management team had been through Project Argus just four days prior.

Underpinning all of this is the need for fast and effective communication with our businesses which we provide via the Merlin Protect 24/7 platform from Global Aware International. Signing up to receive messages through the platform is available to the 900+ businesses across both BID areas and we serve as both system administrator and primary message sender – acting as the link between the emergency services and businesses. Content typically includes: detail of planned road closures and protests; crime prevention advice; local intelligence on criminal/fraudulent activity; forthcoming events such as Argus and ACT Awareness; CSSC & TINYg messages and real-time updates during major incidents. We have access to an integrated social media monitoring tool which continuously searches for customisable phrases and sends email alerts when found, and are also able to store key documents such as business continuity plans securely within the platform. We're the first Business Improvement Districts to use Merlin Protect 24/7 and have enjoyed working alongside Global Aware to develop a product that is built to our needs and therefore highly cost-effective and simple to use. We hope that other Business Improvement Districts may see the benefits in rolling out something similar for their communities across the UK.




